AKC Safety Rules

We all play a part in keeping our areas clean and safe. This includes practicing safe social distancing, respecting the social distance of others, not congregating at common areas, staying away from areas when you're sick and acting responsibly. Conditions may change often and regularly as we receive guidance and recommendations from our public health partners. GSDOC will strictly follow CDC, Utah Department of Health, and Versa Dog Sports rules.

Exhibitors need to bring their own masks, gloves and sanitizer.

1. Upon arrival all participants may undergo a symptom and/or mask check.
 - a. Temperatures may be taken with a non-touch thermometer.
 - b. Exhibitors should supply their own masks.
 - c. Masks worn in settings where other social distancing measures are difficult to maintain.
 - d. Briefings will not be required for Excellent/Master level classes. Masks are required for other class briefings.
 - e. **Masks are required to be worn during walk through.**
 - f. Use social distancing of 6 feet.
 - g. Use 6 feet spacing between setups.
 - h. GSDOC will have sanitizer. It is recommended individuals also have their personal sanitizer and/or gloves.

Updated restrictions or changes will be announced in the trial confirmation letter.

AKC additional recommendations.

1. Exhibitors and committee should consider wearing disposable or washable gloves.
2. Avoid shaking hands or hugging.
3. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.
4. Crating should be at least six feet apart, except for "family" groups of exhibitors and dogs.
5. Meals:
 - a. No Potlucks. This includes breakfast snacks and drinks.
 - b. Exhibitors need to bring their own food and drinks. There are fast food establishments within a short distance (abt. 3-5 miles) of Versa Dog Sports. GSDOC will have bottled water available.
 - c. Box lunches will be provided for the judge and volunteers.
 - d. No MACH cakes.
6. Leave one car parking space between vehicles.
7. Leashes for the rest of 2020:
 - a. Exhibitors may place leashes in their pockets when running the course or wear them on themselves i.e. clip like a belt around the waist.
 - b. If the dog grabs the leash while running this will be scored as an "E".
 - c. GSDOC will not have a leash runner at these trials.
8. Only VMO's can measure dogs.
9. The monitor of trial results will not be available to avoid gathering at the screen.
10. Trial results will be posted on an outside wall to avoid gathering at books.
11. Ribbons and stickers are not self-service; we will make every effort to have ribbons/stickers available as quickly as possible after the judge has finished certification.
12. Course maps will be posted in two locations. Copies of maps will not be printed. It is suggested exhibitors take pictures of the maps with their phones.

GSDOC trial committee has worked many hours to be able to sponsor this trial during the Covid-19 pandemic. We are looking forward to having a great trial. RETURN SIGNED WAIVER WITH ENTRY

Versa Dog Training, LLC

Waiver of Claims, Assumption of Risk, and Acceptance of Financial Responsibility Agreement

In consideration of services, and/or training, activities, events, etc. afforded by Versa Dog Training, LLC, Kristin Sittner, their agents owners, officer, volunteers, participants, employees and all other persons or entities acting in any capacity on their behalf (collectively referred to as “**VDT**”), I hereby release and discharge **VDT** on behalf of myself, my children, my parents, my heirs, assigns, personal representative and estate as follows:

- 1) I acknowledge that performance dog training, activities and events, including, but not limited to obedience, agility, trick dog, and sheep herding (collectively, the “**Activity**”), entails known and unanticipated risks that could result in damage to myself, to property, to my dog(s), to dog(s) in my care, to other dogs or to third parties. I understand that such risks cannot be eliminated without jeopardizing essential qualities of the **Activity**.
 - a. *The risks include, among other things: physical injury to my dog(s) or dog(s) in my care including bodily injuries and possible death; physical injury to myself, injury to livestock or injury to other dogs. Risks also include dangers, known or unknown, resulting from weather, spectators, other students or participants, facilities, staff, terrain, dogs, and livestock.*
- 2) I expressly agree and promise to accept and assume all of the risks existing at the facility during the **Activity**. My participation in the **Activity** is purely voluntary and I elect to participate in spite of the risks. I certify that I have no medical or physical conditions that could interfere with my safety in the **Activity**, or else I am willing to assume – and bear the costs of – all risks that may be created, directly or indirectly, by any such condition.
- 3) I further agree that I will be solely responsible for, and will promptly pay to **VDT**, all costs incurred for any and all damages done to livestock, property or person(s) caused either by myself or by my dog(s) or any dog(s) in my care while participating in the **Activity**.
- 4) I hereby voluntarily release, forever discharge, and agree to indemnify and hold harmless, **VDT** from any and all claims, demands, or causes of action which in anyway are connected with my participation in this **Activity** or my use of **VDT**'s equipment, livestock, property or facilities (“**Claims**”), including any **Claims** that allege negligent acts of omissions of **VDT**.
- 5) Should **VDT**, or anyone acting on their behalf, be required to incur attorney's fees and costs to enforce this Agreement or to defend any **Claims** against **VDT** alleging damages caused directly or indirectly by me, my dog(s), or dog(s) in my care, I agree to indemnify and hold them harmless for all such damages, costs, and attorney fees.

COVID-19 WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION

- 1) I agree that I am personally responsible for my safety and actions while participating in any event at Versa Dog Training, LLC (**VDT**). Because **VDT** is open for use by other individuals, I recognize that I am at higher risk of contracting COVID-19. With full awareness and appreciation of the risks involved, I, for myself and on behalf of my family, spouse, estate, heirs, executors, administrators, assigns, and personal representatives, hereby forever release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue the Versa Dog Training, LLC, Kristin Sittner, independent contractors, affiliates, employees, successors, and assigns (collectively the “**Released Parties**”) from any and all liability, claims, demands, actions, and causes of action whatsoever, directly or indirectly arising

out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury, including death, that may be sustained by me related to COVID-19 whether caused by the negligence of the **Released Parties**, any third-party using **VDT**, or otherwise, while participating in any activity while in, on, or around **VDT** and/or while using any **VDT** facilities, tools, equipment, or materials.

2) I agree that I will not participate in the **Activity** or come to the premises of Versa Dog Training if ANY of the follow are true:

- If you or a household member have any of the following symptoms:
 - Fever (100.4° or greater), cough, new or increased shortness of breath, decreased sense of smell or taste, sore or scratchy throat, or muscle aches and pains.
- If you or a household member have tested positive for Covid-19 within 14 days prior to the start date of the event.
- if you or a household member have recently been exposed to a known case of Covid-19
- if you or a member of your household develop any of the aforementioned symptoms during the **Activity** time frame (i.e. Weekend)

3) By signing below I acknowledge and represent that I have read the foregoing Waiver of Liability, understand it and sign it voluntarily as my own free act and deed, including without limitation the Release of Liability and Indemnification requirements contained in this document; I am sufficiently informed about the risks involved in participating in activities at **VDT**. I am at least eighteen (18) years of age and fully competent; and I execute this document for full, adequate, and complete consideration fully intending to be bound by the same. The Trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry form or left blank by the owner or agent of the owner.

GSDOC is accepting online entries through the AKC Online System. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries will be designated as follows: Online entries: 20% (54), paper entries 80% (216), 270 runs per day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly. Paper entries received within the first 24 hours must include postage or be metered. Entries must be delivered by multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL.

Entries not on official AKC agility entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC agility entry form are invalid. In addition, entries will not be accepted without fees or signature. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Move-up must be made on or before Monday, November 2, 2020, 6:00 PM MDT.

Illegible or incomplete entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Entries not accompanied by the correct fees, or a returned check, or a postdated check do not constitute a valid entry. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their future entries being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Owners are responsible for any errors on entry forms regardless of who makes such errors. No entry fee will be returned in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date. Duplicate entries will not be refunded if already processed.

A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.

GSDOC is offering a waitlist to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing October 23, 2020, 5:00 pm MDT. A maximum of 25 entries will be placed on the club's waitlist. All entries, including waitlisted entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to closing October 23, 2020, 5:00 pm MDT. Any entries withdrawn that are received by October 23, 2020, 5:00 pm MDT will be replaced by a first received waitlisted entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a waitlisted entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any waitlisted entry that does not move off the waitlist into the trial by October 23, 2020, 5:00 pm MDT will receive a full refund.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. Female dogs that come into season after entries close and up to 30 min before the start of the trial, will receive a full refund of their entry fee minus a \$5.00 processing fee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the club, trial committee or trial secretary.

Golden Spike Dog Obedience Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against GSDOC, the trial secretary, or any officials thereof.

The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

JUDGING INFORMATION

Check-in will begin at 7:00a.m. First dog on the line at 8:00a.m. all days. Electronic timers, rubberized contacts and safety jumps will be used.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. Neither the club nor the Trial Secretary have any obligation or responsibility to provide a service through a public address system, or stewards, or runners, for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Exhibitors in all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog during a walk thru period held prior to the start of the class. The walk thru is restricted to handlers entered in that class. Exhibitors must wear a face mask.

FAST class walk thru will be nested for all levels to walk/run together.

Judges Briefing may be done over a ring speaker so exhibitors may stay spread out. Exhibitors do not have to come into the ring for briefing – they may stay outside of the ring. Briefings will not be required for Excellent/Master level classes.

Warmup area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warmup area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

Measuring and Height Card Information

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible and neither are aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds. After the close of entries, a dog, which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler, may be moved to the Novice "B" class. A request must be submitted to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of EACH trial and must state the reason and justification for the move. A dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e., Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. (Chapter 1 Section 21)

January 1, 2020 Rule

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020 Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day. Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day. **A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.** When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms. (Chapter 5 Section 8). FEO is not offered at these trials.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place.....	Blue
Second Place.....	Red
Third Place.....	Yellow
Fourth Place	White
Qualifying Score	Dark Green

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH rosette and MACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH. A PACH rosette and PACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their PACH. Please let the trial secretary know if you are close to attaining your MACH or PACH when you send in your entry so we can celebrate with you.

Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
